The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) works with County Boards of DD and other related agencies to ensure the availability of supports to help people live as they choose.

A Medicaid waiver is a funding source that allows individuals to live in the community with supports.

Individuals with this funding can select providers of their choice and many are looking for help with adaptations and renovations to their homes!

Applicants who are interested in providing Home Modification services under the Waiver may apply for certification through the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD).

**Home Modifications (Environmental Accessibility Adaptations)** are changes to a home that enable a person to function with greater independence.

Examples of **Home Modifications** are:

- Installing ramps or door openers
- Widening doorways
- Modifying bathrooms for accessibility
- Installing ceiling tracking
- Installing wheelchair lifts / stair glides
- Installing grab bars and hand rails
- Convert bathtubs to step-in showers
- Installing fences and gates
- Custom polycarbonate enclosures
- Window and door chimes or locks
