Service and Support Administrators (SSA) work with youth ages 3 through graduation who are Board eligible to navigate the DD system and engage in support services. The SSA can support the journey through childhood with the goal of full community membership. The SSA is a trouble-shooter, a problem-solver and a resource for the child.

How do we do this?

- * Developing a Person Centered Plan
- * Facilitating Team meetings and home/community visits to coordinate services and supports based on the individual's needs related to their disability
- * Collaborating with other professionals to move towards successful transitions in school and from school to adulthood
- * Empowering the child and family to self advocate
- * Utilizing Specialized supports for social emotional challenges
- * Utilizing community supports to help foster growth and development
