The Ability Center Youth and Transition Services are offered to youth and their families to support independent living goals through best practices and partnerships with schools, service agencies and community organizations. Staff engage youth with activities that align with their skills, interests, and goals. Ages 13-17: 5:00pm

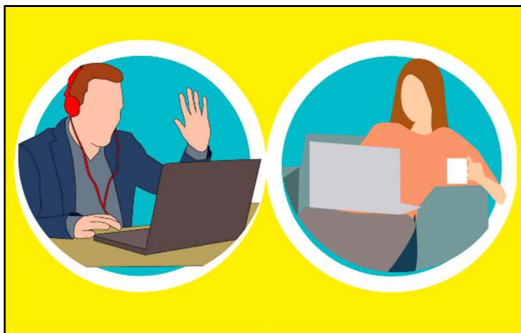
Those 18 or over who cannot make the 10am session due to being in school may attend the 5pm session.
